

## Owen Poem Abseil Terms and Conditions

1. Participants must be at least 16 years of age; under 18's must have a parent or guardian present and they must sign a permission slip on the day of the abseil.
2. All participants must provide us with emergency contacts details either prior or on the day of the event at the time of registration.
3. Participants must be physically fit to take part in the abseil, please do not take part if you feel unwell. We strongly recommend that you seek advice from your GP if you have any concerns about taking part in this activity. Participants must inform the MHA representative and/or Dolomite Training Staff of any health concerns or medical issues that you feel may affect your ability to undertake the activity safely.
4. Participants must weigh 130kg / 17 stone or less.
5. Participants must arrive 30 minutes before their designated time slot to ensure they are fully registered and briefed beforehand. Participants who arrive late may be unable to take part; this will be decided at the discretion of the organisers on the day.
6. Participants who do not act responsibly and do not adhere to the instruction of MHA representatives or Dolomite Training will be held fully responsible for any costs incurred arising from an accident caused by the participant's negligent behaviour.
7. To the extent permitted by the Unfair Contract Terms Act neither MHA nor their sponsors or suppliers will be liable for any loss, damage, illness or injury resulting from negligence in the participants actions.
8. Dolomite Training staff are granted permission to sanction emergency medical first aid care required during the event.
9. Participant's medical details and emergency contact details will be released to organisers and any statutory authorities in the event of a medical emergency.
10. MHA will not be responsible for any loss, theft or damage to personal belongings, other than caused as a result of negligence or breach of statutory duty.
11. In the event of the abseil having to be cancelled due to circumstances outside of MHA's control, the event will be rescheduled where possible to ensure participants can join on another date or registration fees will be refunded.
12. MHA have a contract with Dolomite Training, an expert and experienced outdoor pursuit company, to deliver this event.
13. There will be a photographer and videographer on site on the day to document the event for our social media channels and future marketing and publicity purposes. If you do not wish to have your photo taken please contact an MHA representative on the day on the event.
14. MHA will contact participants via email and/or telephone in relation to their involvement in the event.
